Bear in mind that the new caption - boundary from sources below - is rather misleading because the sources include conflicting depictions of the boundary. The BLM GIS source depicts the boundary currently recognized by the Federal Gov't whereas the State of Alaska GIS source depicts the state's (and Congressional delegation's) perspective of the boundary. I'm not asking to revise the caption - just making sure everyone is aware.

Chris - I've talked with our Acting Director and Dave H. and they want to go forward with changes below to map (Dave will reach out as well to you to confirm):

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I'll hold until further instructions.

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Sorry, this is a NO GO!

The ANWR boundary as currently recognized by the Federal Government does NOT correspond the the boundary depicted by this map, which is a proposed boundary that has not been adopted by the Federal Government.

This issue was thoroughly discussed, debated, and settled upon early last spring (as you well know). Bottom line: we cannot be put in the

position of the USGS advocating for a Federal boundary change, which is what we would be doing by producing a map that does not attribute the depicted boundary to a specific external source.

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

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

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
