

Supervisor/Management Official



Employees have multiple options for reporting allegations of harassment, one of which is contacting a supervisor/management official. Any employee who has been subjected to harassing misconduct is **encouraged to** report the matter to the supervisor of the employee engaging in the harassing misconduct, or another supervisor or other management official. In addition, employees who know of or witness possible harassing misconduct directed at others are **expected to** report the matter.

Talking with a Supervisor/Management Official about alleged harassment DOES constitute an act of reporting.
