TUNGSTEN IN SEPTEMBER 2018

U.S. net production of intermediate tungsten products, including metal powder and tungsten carbide powder, was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. imports of selected materials in January through September 2018 was 6% less than that imported during the same period in 2017 (table 2). The amount of tungsten contained in U.S. exports of selected materials in January through September 2018 was 15% less than that exported during the same period in 2017 (table 3).

Prices

Weekly prices for ammonium paratungstate, as reported in Platts Metals Week, remained unchanged from mid-May 2018 through the end of September. The September 2018 monthly average price was 11% higher than that in September 2017. Platt's weekly prices for tungsten concentrates remained unchanged from mid- to late June through the end of September. The September 2018 monthly average price for tungsten concentrates was 12% higher than that in September 2017. The

following prices for September 2018, in dollars per metric ton unit, were converted from short-ton-unit prices and rounded to the nearest dollar:

Ammonium paratungstate, U.S. free market:

Low—\$353/metric ton unit WO₃ (\$320/short ton unit WO₃)

High—\$397/metric ton unit WO₃ (\$360/short ton unit WO₃)

Concentrates:

Low—\$309/metric ton unit WO₃ (\$280/short ton unit WO₃)

High—\$353/metric ton unit WO₃ (\$320/short ton unit WO₃)*
