### **SILVER IN DECEMBER 2019**

U.S. mines produced 77,200 kilograms (kg) of silver in December 2019 (table 1). Based on unrounded data, the average daily silver production in December was 2,490 kg, a 14% decrease compared with the 2,890 kg in November, and 13% less than the 2,850 kg in December 2018. U.S. mines produced 971,000 kilograms of silver in 2019, based on unrounded data, the average daily silver production in 2019 was 2,660 kg, a 4% increase compared with the 2018 daily production of 2,560 kg.

#### **Prices**




Figure 1. Engelhard monthly silver prices for December 2017 through December 2019. Source: Platts Metals Week.

In December 2019, the Engelhard average daily silver price was \$17.17 per troy ounce, essentially unchanged from that in November. The daily price in December ranged between a high of \$18.05 per troy ounce on December 26 and a low of \$16.63 per troy ounce on December 9. In 2019, the Engelhard average daily silver price was \$16.23 per troy ounce, a 3% increase from that in 2018. The daily price in 2019 ranged between a high of \$19.40 per troy ounce on September 4 and a low of \$14.37 per troy ounce on May 28 (fig. 1, table 2).

#### **Trade**

In December 2019, imports of silver in the form of bullion, doré, and ores and concentrates totaled 413,000 kg, a 9% increase from that in November. This increase was caused by increases in imports of silver bullion and doré, which increased in December by 8% and 10%, respectively compared with those in November. In 2019, imports of silver in the form of bullion, doré, and ores and concentrates totaled 4,770,000 kg, a slight decrease from the previous year. This decrease was driven by a decrease in imports of silver doré, which decreased by 10% to 973,000 kg in 2019 from 1,080,000 kg in 2018 (table 3).

In December 2019, exports of silver in the form of bullion, doré, and ores and concentrates totaled 7,410 kg, a 24% decrease from that in November and a 43% decrease from that in October. This decrease was caused by a 64% and 67% decrease in exports of bullion in November and October,

respectively. In 2019, exports of silver in the form of bullion, doré, and ores and concentrates totaled 220,000 kg, a decrease of 64% from the previous year. This decrease was driven by a decrease in exports of bullion, which decreased by 66% to 189,000 kg from 557,000 kg in 2018; doré, which decreased by 20% to 29,900 kg from 37,600 kg in 2018; and ores and concentrates, which decreased 97% to 234 kg from 7,830 kg in 2018 (table 5).

#### **Update**

On March 9, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the Federal Trade Commission issued warning letters to seven companies who were selling fraudulent Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) products. The products cited in the warning letters included colloidal silver. The FDA had previously stated that colloidal silver, which is particles of silver suspended within a liquid, is not safe or effective for treating any disease or condition. Companies that make claims that it prevents, cures, or treats cases of COVID-19 may be subject to legal action, including, but not limited to seizure or injunction (U.S. Food and Drug Administration, 2020).
