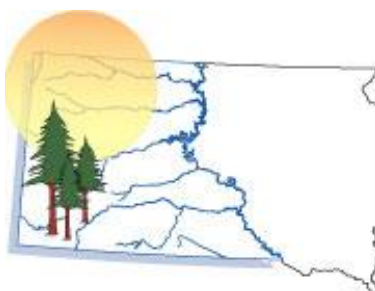

- » Abstracts should state the purpose, results, and relevant conclusions in 300 words or less.
- » Abstracts should be submitted in Microsoft Word or plain text.
- » **When submitting an abstract, please indicate oral presentation or poster, and desired time slot (20 or 30 mins).**
