Advisory Committee on Antarctic Names (ACAN) Name Proposal Form

<u>Advisory Committee on Antarctic Names</u> is responsible for considering geographic feature names for recommendation to the U.S. Board on Geographic Names for official recognition by the United States.

This form should be used to submit a proposal, whether a new name for an unnamed feature, or to change an existing name, spelling, or location. A proponent should:

- 1. Carefully review the proposal prior to submission to ensure that it is consistent with <u>ACAN Policies</u>.
- Search <u>GNIS Query Form for Antarctica</u> to determine if the proposed name is already used, and for commemorative names, if the intended honoree (whether a person, organization, expedition) already has a named feature in Antarctica.
- 3. Save completed PDF as 'ACAN_GeographicName' for example 'ACAN_DiscoveryGlacier' or 'ACAN_JohnSmith'

Please note all fields with a red outline are required.

The proponent should be aware that the entire proposal — including personal identifying information and any associated correspondence — may be made publicly available at any time.
