Hello,

I would like to open a case to review a potential map error in the USGS National Map Viewer. A landowner on one of the drainage boards with whom I work closely brought this to my attention. He asked me to see if I could have the map corrected. I am told that Little River is misrepresented in the southwestern tip of Clay County near the Black River in Arkansas. The confluence of the two rivers in question is near ear Hubble Bridge (approximately N 36° 17' 50.23", W 90° 41' 55.25").

According to my contact, Little River is misplaced. It should instead be represented by the next river to the west, represented on the USGS map by the dotted line. Little River is perennial, but it should run along the purple line (see USGS map), and the area circled in red should instead denote the intermittent Rankine stream. I've included the supporting maps that were shared with me. Little River-Rankine Inverted map is a snapshot of another USGS map. The other maps A & B were created by a private company. Let me know if you would like additional map details or documentation to affirm the claims of a mapping error. I have no personal knowledge of this area, but I trust the knowledge of my colleagues on this matter.


