## Kinds of Pathways Internships Available

### Internship

(must be a current student; position is for one year increment or less).

Available in all USGS mission areas.

Available to all levels of students in accredited high schools; colleges (including community/junior colleges, 4-year colleges/universities); professional, technical, vocational, or trade schools; advanced degree programs; or other educational institutions while pursuing a qualifying degree or certificate.

### Recent Graduate

(must have graduated within the past two years from a qualifying educational institution or certificate program).
