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SILVER IN JUNE 2022




Figure 1. Monthly domestic production of silver in the United States from June 2020 through June 2022.

U.S. mines produced 82,500 kilograms (kg) of silver in June 2022 (table 1). Based on unrounded data, the average daily silver production in June was 2,750 kg, a 5% increase from the revised daily silver production of 2,610 kg in May 2022, and a 9% decrease from the daily silver production of 3,010 kg in June 2021. For the first half of the year, U.S. mines produced a total of 504,000 kg of silver, a slight decrease from the 516,000 kg of silver produced in the same time period in 2021 (fig. 1, table 1).

Prices

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


Figure 2. Engelhard monthly silver prices for June 2020 through June 2022. Source: S&P Global Platts Metals Week.

In June 2022, the Engelhard average daily silver price was \$21.68 per troy ounce, a slight decrease from the May 2022 average daily price of \$22.05 per troy ounce, a 20% decrease from that in June 2021, and 22% greater than that in June 2020. The daily price in June ranged between a low of \$20.70 per troy ounce and a high of \$22.50 per troy ounce. (fig. 2, table 2).

Trade

In June 2022 imports of silver in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates totaled 400,000 kg, 7% less than that in May 2022, and 26% less than that in June 2021. This decrease from the previous month was owing to decreased imports of silver bullion and dore, which decreased by 7% and 8% respectively. Imports of silver bullion decreased from Kazakhstan (52,400 kg) and Hong Kong (12,600 kg), Canada (11,100 kg), and Chile (10,100 kg), but was partially offset by increased imports of silver bullion from Switzerland, (23,700 kg), Poland (18,500 kg), the Republic of Korea (17,500 kg), and Uzbekistan (10,100 kg)). The leading import sources of silver in June 2021 in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates were (in descending order): Mexico (165,000 kg), Canada (56,400 kg), Turkey (36,400 kg) Republic of Korea (35,500 kg), and Switzerland (27,700 kg).

For the first six months of 2022, imports of silver in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates totaled 2,280,000 kg, 30% less than that in the same time period of 2021 (table 3). This decrease was owing to decreased imports of silver bullion and dore, which had decreased by 31% and 28% respectively. Imports of silver bullion decreased from Switzerland (352,000 kg), Poland (162,000 kg), and Canada (112,000 kg). The leading import sources of silver bullion in 2022 were Mexico (747,000 kg), Canada (385,000 kg), Turkey (159,000 kg), the Republic of Korea (135,000 kg), and Kazakhstan (130,000 kg).
