# **SILVER IN JANUARY 2023**




Figure 1. Monthly domestic production of silver in the United States from January 2021 through January 2023.

U.S. mines produced 87,500 kilograms (kg) of silver in January 2023 (table 1). Based on unrounded data, the average daily silver production in January was 2,820 kg, a 5% decrease from the revised average daily silver production of 2,970 kg in December 2022, and unchanged from the average daily silver production of 2,830 kg for the full year 2022 (fig. 1, table 1).

#### **Prices**




Figure 2. Engelhard monthly silver prices for January 2021 through January 2023. Source: S&P Global Platts Metals Week.

In January 2023, the Engelhard average daily silver price was \$23.90 per troy ounce, a slight increase from the December 2022 average daily price of \$23.44 per troy ounce, a 3% increase from that in January 2022, and an 8% decrease from that in January 2021. The daily price in January ranged between a high of \$24.70 per troy ounce and low of \$23.10 per troy ounce (fig. 2, table 2).

#### Trade

In January 2023 imports of silver in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates totaled 388,000 kg, a 20% decrease from that in December 2022. This decrease from the previous month was owing to decreased imports of silver bullion which decreased by 24% but was partially offset by increased imports of silver dore, which slightly increased from December 2022.

Imports of silver bullion decreased from Canada (49,400 kg), Mexico (18,800 kg), Belgium (18,000 kg), Turkey (16,100 kg), and Uzbekistan (4,470 kg), but were partially offset by increased imports of silver bullion from Poland (18,500 kg) and South Korea (18,400 kg). Imports of dore increased from Mexico (8,310 kg), Nicaragua (422 kg), and Canada (238 kg). The leading import sources of silver in January 2023 in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates were: Mexico (203,000 kg), Canada (80,400 kg), Turkey (25,500 kg), Chile (24,100 kg), and South Korea (20,000 kg) (table 3).

#### News

On January 11, Hecla Mining Co. reported estimated 2022 silver production of 442,000 kg (14.2 million troy ounces), which was their second highest production of silver and an increase of 10% compared with 2021 production. The increase was attributed to increased production at both Greens Creek and Lucky Friday mines. Hecla also announced that their Keno Hill development, located in the Yukon Territory of Canada, was on schedule with production planned to start in the third quarter of 2023.
