MANGANESE IN MARCH 2023




Figure 1. Monthly imports of manganese (Mn) ore from March 2021 through March 2023. Source: U.S. Census Bureau.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. imports of manganese ore in March 2023 decreased by 23% to 1,060 metric tons (t) from 1,360 t in February 2023 (fig. 1, table 5). In March 2023, South Africa was the sole source of manganese ore >20%-<47% grade and >47% grade. Total imports of manganese ore for the first three months of 2023 were 69% less than that during the same period in 2022.

Prices

In March 2023, the average spot prices for manganese ore deliveries to China were \$4.63 per metric ton unit, 36%–38% grade, and \$5.78 per metric ton unit, 44% grade, slightly more and essentially unchanged, respectively, compared to the




Figure 2. Average monthly spot prices for manganese (Mn) ore delivered to China from March 2021 through March 2023. Source: CRU Group.

February 2023 prices (fig. 2, table 1). Compared with the monthly average prices in March 2022, the 36%–38% grade price was 11% less and the 44% grade price was 16% less.
