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SILVER IN MARCH 2023




Figure 1. Monthly domestic production of silver in the United States from March 2021 through March 2023.

U.S. mines produced 92,300 kilograms (kg) of silver in March 2023 (table 1). Based on unrounded data, the average daily silver production in March was 3,010 kg, unchanged from the average daily silver production in February 2023, and a 6% increase from the average daily silver production of 2,830 kg for the full year 2022 (fig. 1, table 1).


Prices

In March 2023, the Engelhard average daily silver price was \$22.08 per troy ounce, unchanged from the February 2023 average daily price of \$22.13 per troy ounce, a 13% decrease from that in March 2022, and a 14% decrease from that in March 2021. The daily price in March ranged between a high of \$24.20 per troy ounce and low of \$20.15 per troy ounce (fig. 2, table 2).

Trade

In March 2023, imports of silver in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates totaled 391,000 kg, a 18% increase from that in February 2023. This increase from the previous month was owing to increased imports of silver bullion which increased by 21%. Imports of silver bullion increased from Mexico (37,600 kg), Canada (36,000 kg), Switzerland (1,200 kg), Taiwan (68 kg), and United Kingdom (39 kg), but were partially offset by decreased imports of silver bullion from Chile (10,900 kg), Republic of Korea (7,890 kg), and Turkey (3,980 kg). Imports of dore increased from Mexico (3,160 kg) and Germany (727 kg) but decreased from Argentina (916 kg) and Canada (408 kg). The leading import sources of silver in March 2023 in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates were: Mexico (235,000 kg), Canada (98,300 kg), Turkey (15,400 kg), Chile (11,700 kg), and the Republic of Korea (10,600 kg) (table 3).
