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MARKETABLE PHOSPHATE ROCK JUNE 2023

U.S. marketable phosphate rock production in June 2023 was estimated to be 1.76 million metric tons (Mt), which was 5% lower than that in May and 3% lower than that in June 2022 (table 1). Total phosphate rock production in January through June was estimated to be 9.93 Mt, which was essentially unchanged from the revised amount in the same period of 2022.

Phosphate rock sold or used in the United States in June 2023 was estimated to be 1.70 Mt, which was 5% higher than that in May and 16% higher than that in June 2022. Total phosphate rock sold or used in January through June was estimated to be 10.6 Mt, which was 5% higher than the revised amount in the same period of 2022. U.S. producer stocks were estimated to be essentially unchanged from than those in May and 3% lower than the revised amount in June 2022 (table 1).

Imports of phosphate rock in June 2023 were 183,000 metric tons, which was 10% lower than those in May and 4% higher

than those in June 2022. Total imports for January through June were 1.31 Mt, which was 25% higher than those in same period in 2022 (table 2). Imports of phosphate rock can vary substantially from month to month based on sales contracts and production schedules of the phosphate plants.

Estimated apparent consumption for 2023, based on annualized data, was 23.9 Mt compared with 21.9 Mt in 2022 (table 3).
