SILVER IN NOVEMBER 2023




Figure 1. Monthly domestic production of silver in the United States from November 2021 through November 2023.

U.S. mines produced 70,400 kilograms (kg) of silver in November 2023 (table 1). Based on unrounded data, the average daily silver production in November was 2,350 kg, 8% lower than the average daily silver production in October 2023, and a 15% decrease from the average daily silver production of 2,760 kg for the full year 2022 (fig. 1, table 1).

Prices


In November 2023, the Engelhard average daily silver price was \$23.61 per troy ounce, up 5% from the October 2023 average daily price of \$22.44 per troy ounce, and an 11% increase from that in November 2022, but a 3% decrease from that in November 2021. The daily price in November ranged

between a high of \$25.35 per troy ounce and low of \$22.25 per troy ounce (fig. 2, table 2).

Trade

In November 2023, imports of silver in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates totaled 403,000 kg, essentially unchanged from that in October 2023. There was a 14% increase in imports of bullion which was partially offset by an 45% decrease in silver dore. Imports of silver bullion increased from Canada (55,000 kg), Germany (19,600 kg), the Republic of Korea (14,600 kg), and Turkey (5,870 kg), but were partially offset by decreased imports of silver bullion from Mexico (19,100 kg), Poland (12,000 kg), Kazakhstan (9,790 kg), Chile (6,580 kg), Peru (3,080 kg), and Switzerland (2,040 kg). The decrease in imports of dore was attributed to Canada (17,400 kg), Sweden (15,000 kg), and Mexico (6,190 kg) but there was an increase in imports of dore from Germany (521 kg) and Peru (500 kg). The leading import sources of silver in November 2023 in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates were: Mexico (200,000 kg), Canada (99,600 kg), the Republic of Korea (33,900 kg), Germany (21,500 kg), Turkey (18,000 kg), and Chile (17,200 kg) (table 3).
