# **SILVER IN DECEMBER 2023**




Figure 1. Monthly domestic production of silver in the United States from December 2021 through December 2023.

U.S. mines produced 81,100 kilograms (kg) of silver in December 2023 (table 1). Based on unrounded data, the average daily silver production in December was 2,620 kg, 11% higher than the revised average daily silver production in November 2023, and a 5% decrease from the average daily silver production of 2,760 kg for the full year 2022. Full year 2023 production was 998,000 kg which was essentially unchanged from that in 2022 (fig. 1, table 1).

#### Prices


In December 2023, the Engelhard average daily silver price was \$24.07 per troy ounce, a slight increase from the November 2023 average daily price of \$23.61 per troy ounce, and a 3% increase from that in December 2022, as well as a 7% increase from that in December 2021. The daily price in December

ranged between a high of \$25.25 per troy ounce and low of \$22.75 per troy ounce (fig. 2, table 2).

#### Trade

In December 2023, imports of silver in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates totaled 593,000 kg, a 47% increase from that in November 2023. There was a 49% increase in imports of bullion and a 32% increase in imports of silver dore between December and November 2023. Imports of silver bullion increased from Mexico (54,300 kg), Canada (53,300 kg), Germany (19,400 kg), Poland (18,500 kg), Chile (15,700 kg) and Switzerland (10,600 kg) but were partially offset by decreased imports of silver bullion from the Republic of Korea (9,120 kg), Bolivia (1,970 kg) and Colombia (1,140 kg). The increase in imports of dore was attributed to Mexico (16,400 kg) and Argentina (2,480 kg), but there was a decrease in imports of dore from Chile (3,130 kg), Germany (522 kg) and Peru (501 kg). The leading import sources of silver in December 2023 in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates were: Mexico (270,000 kg), Canada (154,000 kg), Germany (40,400 kg), Chile (29,800 kg), the Republic of Korea (24,800 kg), and Turkey (22,000 kg) (table 3).
