BAUXITE AND ALUMINA IN THE FIRST QUARTER 2023




Figure 1. Quarterly imports of crude and dried bauxite from the first quarter of 2021 through the first quarter of 2023. Sources: Jamaica Bauxite Institute and U.S. Census Bureau.

Imports of crude and dried bauxite in the first quarter of 2023 were 462,000 metric tons (t), 39% less than those in the fourth quarter of 2022, 37% less than those in the first quarter of 2022, and 33% less than that in the first quarter of 2021. Jamaica (96%) was the main source of crude and dried bauxite imports in the first quarter of 2023 (fig. 1, table 1).




Figure 2. Alumina exports and imports from the first quarter of 2021 through the first quarter of 2023. Sources: Jamaica Bauxite Institute and U.S. Census Bureau

Imports of alumina during the first quarter of 2023 were 323,000 t, 36% less than those in the fourth quarter of 2022, 27% less than those in the first quarter of 2022, and 22% less than those in the first quarter of 2021. The leading sources of imported alumina in the first quarter of 2023 were Brazil (83%) and Canada (7%) (fig. 2, table 3).

Exports of alumina during the first quarter of 2023 were 33,600 t, 30% less than those in the fourth quarter of 2022, 17% less than those in the first quarter of 2022, and 28% less than those in the first quarter of 2021. The leading destinations for alumina exported in the first quarter of 2023 were Mexico (23%); Canada (22%); and China (12%) (fig. 2, table 3).

Updates

On April 25, Century Aluminum Co. announced that it would acquire a 55% stake in the Jamalco alumina refinery from Noble

Group Holdings Ltd. for \$1. The remaining stake is held by Clarendon Alumina Production Ltd., owned by the Government of Jamaica. Located in Clarendon, Jamaica, the Jamalco alumina refinery has a production capacity of 1.4 million tons per year (Mt/yr). As rationale for the acquisition, Century cited increased control of its supply chain for alumina used by its three smelters in the United States which can consume 1.4 Mt/yr of alumina. The Government did not object to the transaction and stated that Century would be responsible for investments to repair damage caused by a fire that shut down production in 2021 (Century Aluminum Co., 2023; Government of Jamaica Ministry of Finance and the Public Service, 2023; Jamaica Observer, 2023).

On April 27, Glencore plc (Switzerland) announced the acquisition of a 45% stake in Mineracão Rio do Norte S.A. and a 30% stake in Alunorte S.A. from Norsk Hydro ASA (Norway). The deal is expected to close in the second half of 2023 for approximately \$700 million. Mineracão Rio do Norte produces bauxite from a 12.5-Mt/yr mine in Trombetas, Brazil. Alunorte operates a 6.3-Mt/yr alumina refinery in Barcarena, Brazil. Glencore indicated that the deal would expand material offerings available to its customers (Glencore plc, 2023).

Tianshan Aluminum Group (China) announced the acquisition of PT Inti Tambang Makmur (Indonesia) for about

\$30 million. PT Inti Tambang Makmur owns mining rights to three bauxite mines in the Kalimantan Province of Indonesia. One mine has an estimated 68 Mt bauxite reserve, while reserves for the other 2 mines were unreported. Tianshan Aluminum has a reported alumina capacity of 2.5 Mt/yr and a primary aluminum capacity of 1.2 Mt/yr (S&P Global Platts Metals Daily, 2023).
