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### **GYPSUM IN THE SECOND QUARTER 2023**

Producers mined 5.51 million metric tons (Mt) of gypsum during the second quarter of 2023. That was 3% more than the first quarter of 2023 and essentially unchanged from the amount of the second quarter of 2022. Synthetic gypsum utilized was estimated to be 3.63 Mt in the second quarter of 2023, which was unchanged from those in the first quarter of 2023 and the second quarter of 2022. During the second quarter of 2023, synthetic gypsum accounted for approximately 32% of the 11.3-Mt total supply of gypsum in the United States (table 1). Both mined and synthetic gypsum are used as raw material for wallboard. The wallboard industry is the leading domestic consumer of gypsum.

Calcined gypsum production during the second quarter of 2023 was 4.79 Mt, which was slightly more than that of the first quarter of 2023 and essentially unchanged from the second quarter of 2022 (table 1). Sales of board products were 3.96 Mt, equivalent to approximately 635 million square meters (6.85 billion square feet), slightly more than those of the first quarter of 2023, and 5% less than those of the second quarter of 2022 (table 2).

Sales of uncalcined gypsum in the second quarter of 2023, primarily for portland cement and agricultural uses, were estimated to be 4.95 Mt, essentially unchanged from those of the first quarter of 2023 and unchanged from those of the second quarter of 2022 (table 2).

The occurrence of quarterly fluctuations is not unusual in the production and consumption of gypsum, synthetic gypsum, and calcined gypsum. These variances are often the result of differences in weather conditions, which can impede or encourage construction activities, coupled with market demands that are often driven by residential and commercial building activity.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, imports of crude gypsum in the second quarter of 2023 were 2.20 Mt, 20% more

than those of the first quarter of 2023 and 8% more than those of the second quarter of 2022. Spain was the leading source with 35% of total crude imports, followed by Mexico with 29%, and Canada with 28% (table 3).

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, gypsum wallboard imports from 8 countries or localities in the second quarter of 2023 were 215,000 t, equivalent to about 23.9 million square meters (257 million square feet). These imports were 4% more than those of the first quarter of 2023 and 4% more than those of the second quarter of 2022. Mexico was the source of 96% of wallboard imports, followed by Canada with 3%.

Wallboard exports to 31 countries or localities in the second quarter of 2023 were 179,000 t, equivalent to 19.9 million square meters (214 million square feet). These were slightly less than those of the first quarter of 2023 and 7% more than those of the second quarter of 2022. Most wallboard exports were shipped to Canada, which accounted for 95% of the total.

Changes in wallboard import and export data are frequently amplified as a result of relatively small quantities of traded material.

All percentages in this report were calculated based on unrounded data.
