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## MARKETABLE PHOSPHATE ROCK MARCH 2025

U.S. marketable phosphate rock production in March was estimated to be 1.61 million metric tons (Mt), slightly lower than that in February and the same as that in March 2024 (table 1). Total production in January through March was estimated to be 4.85 Mt, slightly higher than that in the same period of 2024.

Phosphate rock sold or used in the United States in March was estimated to be 1.75 Mt, 3% lower than that in February and 9% higher than that in March 2024. Total sold or used in January through March was estimated to be 5.26 Mt, 10% higher than that in the same period of 2024.

U.S. producer stocks were estimated to be 9.42 Mt, compared with 9.55 Mt in February and 9.5 Mt in March 2024 (table 1).

Imports of phosphate rock in March were 271,000 metric tons (t), 5% lower than the revised amount in February and 25% lower than those in March 2024 (table 2). Total imports in January through March were 861,000 t, which were 8% lower than those in the same period of 2024. Imports of phosphate rock can vary substantially from month to month based on sales contracts and production schedules of the phosphate plants.

Estimated apparent consumption for 2025, based on annualized sold or used and import data, was 24.8 Mt, compared with 22.4 Mt in 2024 (table 3).
