SILVER IN JUNE 2025




Figure 1. Monthly domestic production of silver in the United States from June 2023 through June 2025.

U.S. mines produced 98,600 kilograms (kg) of silver in June 2025 (table 1). Based on unrounded data, the average daily silver production in June was 3,290 kg compared to the average daily silver production of 3,250 kg in May 2025, and 15% higher than the average daily silver production of 2,870 kg for the full year 2024 (fig. 1, table 1).

Prices




Figure 2. Engelhard monthly silver prices for June 2023 through June 2025. Source: S&P Global Platts Metals Week.

In June 2025, the Engelhard average daily silver price was \$36.07 per troy ounce, 10% higher than the \$32.92 per troy ounce in May 2025. The June 2025 price was 21% higher than the average daily price of \$29.76 per troy ounce in June 2024, and 53% higher than the average daily price of \$23.52 per troy ounce in June 2023. The daily price in June 2025 ranged between the low of \$34.30 per troy ounce on June 2, and a high of \$37.10 per troy ounce on June 18 (fig. 2, table 2).

Trade

In June 2025, imports of silver in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates totaled 404,000 kg compared to the 397,000 kg imported in May 2025. Imports of dore were 51,600 kg in June 2025 which is 14% lower than the 59,900 kg in May

2025, and imports of bullion increased by 6% to 348,000 kg in June 2025 from 329,000 kg in May 2025. The leading import sources of silver in June 2025 in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates were: Mexico (220,000 kg), Canada (62,100 kg), the Republic of Korea (56,100 kg), Poland (18,600 kg), and Belgium (18,500 kg) (table 3). Imports of silver waste and scrap were 88,800 kg in June 2025, up 26% from the 70,700 kg imported in May 2025. Leading import sources for waste and scrap were: Canada (63,000 kg) and Mexico (21,100 kg) (table

In May 2025, exports of silver in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates totaled 45,000 kg, more than 5 times higher than the 7,850 kg exported in May 2025. Exports of dore decreased to 3,830 kg and exports of bullion increased by more than 5 times to 21,100 kg in June 2025 from those in May 2025. The leading export destinations of silver in the form of bullion, dore, and ores and concentrates were: the Republic of Korea (20,000 kg), Canada (19,500 kg), and Switzerland (4,020 kg) (table 5). Exports of silver waste and scrap were 1,230,000 kg in June 2025, up 4% from 1,170,000 kg exported in May 2025. Leading export destinations for silver waste and scrap were: Japan (427,000 kg), Germany (221,000 kg), Italy (165,000 kg), the Republic of Korea (142,000 kg), and Belgium (98,700 kg) (table 6).
