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CEMENT IN SEPTEMBER 2025

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers and the production of clinker in the United States from January 2024 through September 2025. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for September 2025 also are provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement, including imports, in the United States and Puerto Rico in September 2025 were an estimated 9.83 million metric tons (Mt), a 9.7% increase from shipments in September 2024 (tables 1A, 2A, and 2B). Shipments for the year through September totaled an estimated 76.4 Mt, a 1.9% decrease from those for the same period in 2024. Of total blended tonnage reported year-to-date in 2025, 47.2 Mt (95%) was estimated to be portland-limestone cement (Type IL); the leading destination for Type IL shipments by tonnage was Texas. The leading producing States for portland and blended cement in September 2025 were, in descending order, Texas, Missouri, California, Florida, and Michigan; these States accounted for 38.1% of cement produced (table 1A). The leading cement-consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Ohio, and Illinois, in descending order) received 37.2% of shipments in September (tables 2A and 2B).

Masonry cement shipments totaled an estimated 186,000 metric tons in September 2025, a 6.7% increase from those in September 2024 (tables 1B, 2C). Shipments for the year through September totaled an estimated 1.62 Mt, a decrease of 3.4% from those for the same period in 2024. The leading masonry-cement-consuming States in September 2025 were, in descending order, Florida, Texas, North Carolina, California, and Georgia; these States received 53.6% of shipments in September (table 2C).

Clinker production, excluding Puerto Rico, totaled an estimated 6.28 Mt in September 2025, a 5.9% increase from that in September 2024. Production for the year through September totaled an estimated 50.1 Mt, a 4.9% decrease from the same

period in 2024. The leading clinker-producing States in September 2025 were, in descending order, Missouri, Texas, California, Florida, and Alabama (table 4).

Tables 5, 6, and 7 list import data from the U.S. Census Bureau; however, data for clinker imports into the Detroit, MI, and Seattle, WA, customs districts do not include material trucked in from Canada on an informal-entry basis. Monthly imports can show significant year-over-year changes for a variety of reasons and commonly do not correlate well with consumption levels in the respective import districts in the same month. September 2025 imports of cement and clinker, including the San Juan, PR, customs district, totaled 2.34 Mt, an 8.6% increase compared with that in September 2024. Imports for the year through September totaled 19.2 Mt, a 1.7% decrease from those for the same period in 2024.
