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CEMENT IN JANUARY 2026

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers and the production of clinker in the United States from January 2025 through January 2026. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for January 2026 also are provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement, including imports, in the United States and Puerto Rico in January 2026 were an estimated 5.97 million metric tons (Mt), a 3.5 percent increase from revised shipments in January 2025 (tables 1A, 2A, and 2B). Of total blended tonnage reported year-to-date in 2026, 3.45 Mt (96 percent) was estimated to be portland-limestone cement (Type IL); the leading destination for Type IL shipments by tonnage was Texas. The leading producing States for portland and blended cement in January 2026 were, in descending order, Texas, California, Missouri, Florida, and Alabama. The leading cement-consuming States (Texas, Florida, California, Arizona, and Georgia, in descending order) received 49.0 percent of shipments in January (tables 2A and 2B).

Masonry cement shipments totaled an estimated 142,000 metric tons in January 2026, a 1.4 percent decrease from those in January 2025 (tables 1B, 2C). The leading masonry-cement-consuming States in January 2026 were, in descending order, Florida, Texas, California, North Carolina, and Georgia; these States received 60.3 percent of shipments in January (table 2C).

Clinker production, excluding Puerto Rico, totaled an estimated 4.71 Mt in January 2026, a 10.6 percent increase from that in January 2025. The leading clinker-producing States in January 2026 were, in descending order, Missouri, Texas, California, Florida, and Alabama (table 4).

Tables 5, 6, and 7 list import data from the U.S. Census Bureau; however, data for clinker imports into the Detroit, MI,

and Seattle, WA, customs districts do not include material trucked in from Canada on an informal-entry basis. Monthly imports can show significant year-over-year changes for a variety of reasons and commonly do not correlate well with consumption levels in the respective import districts in the same month. January 2026 imports of cement and clinker, including the San Juan, PR, customs district, totaled 1.80 Mt, a 19.2 percent increase from January 2025. An estimate for cement imported by independent importers not participating in the USGS surveys is provided (tables 1A, 2A) but import volumes do not correlate well with consumption levels by domestic final customers in many of the respective import districts. Customs districts affected include, but are not limited to, Houston-Galveston, TX; Miami, FL; New Orleans, LA; Philadelphia, PA; Savannah, GA; and Tampa, FL.
