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CEMENT IN FEBRUARY 2026

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers and the production of clinker in the United States from January 2025 through February 2026. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for February 2026 also are provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement, including imports, in the United States and Puerto Rico in February 2026 were an estimated 6.80 million metric tons (Mt), an 11.3 percent increase from shipments in February 2025 (tables 1A, 2A, and 2B). Shipments for the year through February totaled an estimated 12.8 Mt, a 7.5 percent increase from those for the same period in 2025. Of total blended tonnage reported year-to-date in 2026, 7.59 Mt (96 percent) was estimated to be portland-limestone cement (Type IL); the leading destination for Type IL shipments by tonnage was Texas. The leading producing States for portland and blended cement in February 2026 were, in descending order, Texas, Missouri, California, Florida, and Alabama. The leading cement-consuming States (Texas, Florida, California, Georgia, and Arizona, in descending order) received 48.3 percent of shipments in February (tables 2A and 2B).

Masonry cement shipments totaled an estimated 127,000 metric tons (t) in February 2026, a 15.6 percent decrease from those in February 2025 (tables 1B, 2C). Shipments for the year through February totaled an estimated 269,000 t, a decrease of 8.6 percent from those for the same period in 2025. The leading masonry-cement-consuming States in February 2026 were, in descending order, Florida, Texas, Tennessee, California, and North Carolina; these States received 60.0 percent of shipments in February (table 2C).

Clinker production, excluding Puerto Rico, totaled an estimated 3.92 Mt in February 2026, a 3.7 percent increase from that in February 2025. Production for the year through February totaled an estimated 8.63 Mt, a 6.0 percent increase from the

same period in 2025 (revised). The leading clinker-producing States in February 2026 were, in descending order, Texas, California, Florida, Alabama, and Missouri (table 4).

Tables 5, 6, and 7 list import data from the U.S. Census Bureau; however, data for clinker imports into the Detroit, MI, and Seattle, WA, customs districts do not include material trucked in from Canada on an informal-entry basis. Monthly imports can show significant year-over-year changes for a variety of reasons and commonly do not correlate well with consumption levels in the respective import districts in the same month. February 2026 imports of cement and clinker, including the San Juan, PR, customs district, totaled 1.28 Mt, a 31.4 percent decrease from February 2025. Imports for the year through February totaled 3.08 Mt, a decrease of 8.7 percent from those for the same period in 2025.

An estimate for cement imported by independent importers not participating in the USGS surveys is provided (tables 1A, 2A) but import volumes do not correlate well with consumption levels by domestic final customers in many of the respective import districts. Customs districts affected include, but are not limited to, Houston-Galveston, TX; Miami, FL; New Orleans, LA; Philadelphia, PA; Savannah, GA; and Tampa, FL.
