

USGS WaterAlert Water Safety at Your Fingertips

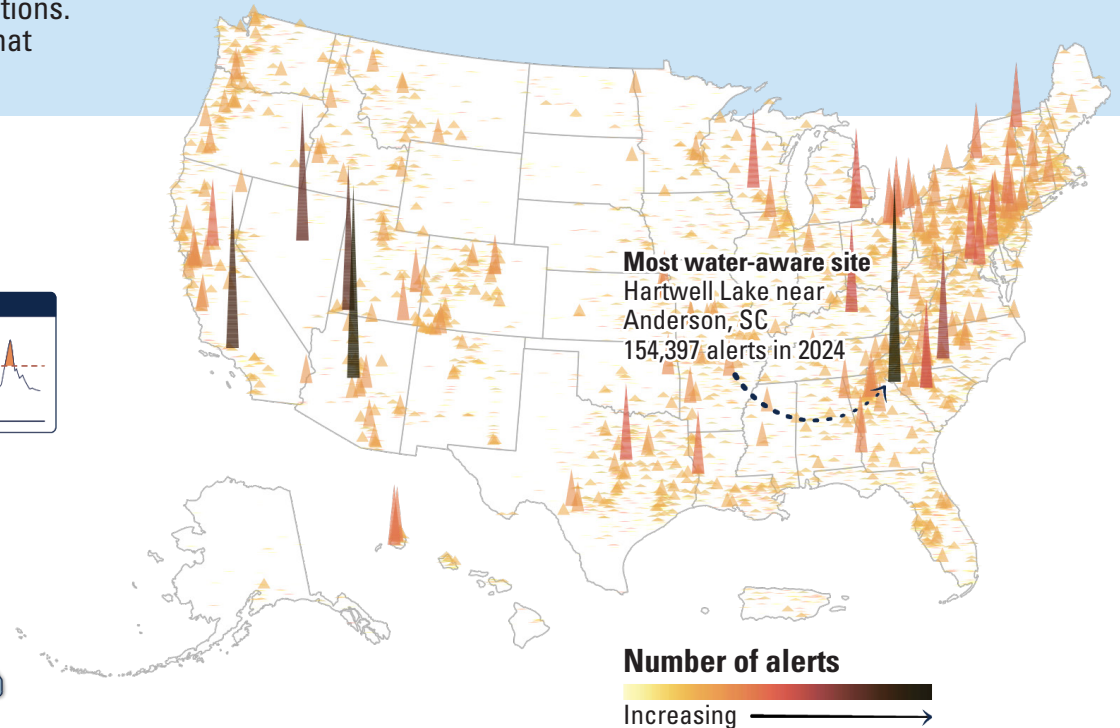
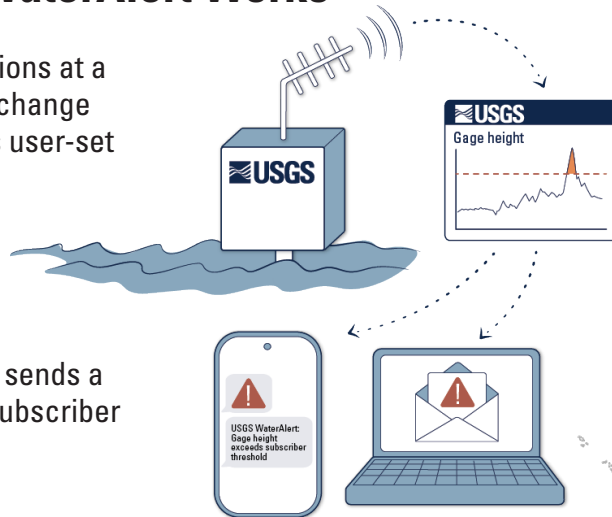
Stay Alert, Stay Safe with USGS WaterAlert, a free service that notifies subscribers of changing water conditions. Alerts can identify potentially dangerous situations, like flows that are too high or too low to safely fish or kayak.

USGS WaterAlert sent 12.6 million alerts to 40,595 subscribers in 2024.

How USGS WaterAlert Works

When water conditions at a USGS streamgage change in a way that meets user-set thresholds...

...USGS WaterAlert sends a notification to the subscriber via text or email.
